







Managing Expectations

- **Temperature** Our travel time is the end of the dry season. This also means it is one of the hotter months 86 96 degrees during the day in some areas.
- **Physical Activity** We will be outdoors for the majority of the trip. Swimming and hiking are just a few of the activities that we will be doing.
- Conservation Work -- A few days will involve research with Mangroves. This will include cleaning and digging in the area.
- Selection We use a lottery to determine participants for our trips.
 Applications must be in by 3pm April 8th to be considered for the lottery.


