<u>Overview</u>

- Bond approved by New York State voters in 2014
- Allocates funds to both public and non-public schools to "finance improved educational technology and infrastructure to improve learning and opportunity for students throughout the State."
- Other approved initiatives include "high-tech security" and pre-K programs. These items, along with any network-related requests, require additional documentation.

<u>Over</u>view |

- There is no deadline for submitting an application for funds.
- Program was designed to use funds over several years or phases.
- There is no timeline for approving funding requests at the state level.
 Intent was for the Smart Schools Review Board to meet quarterly,
 but that has not happened.
